ORDINANCE NO. 262

AN ORDINANCE of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington amending the 2001 budget with revenues and appropriations

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 35A.33 of the Revised Code of Washington, the City is required to adopt an annual budget and provide for procedures for filing of estimates, preliminary budgets, deliberations, public hearings and final fixing of the budget; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Revised Code of Washington, a preliminary budget for the fiscal year 2001 was prepared and filed, requisite public hearings were held for the purpose of fixing a final budget and the City Council made deliberations and adjustments as deemed necessary and proper, and adopted the budget for the City of Lakewood for the fiscal year 2001, which budget was adopted through Ordinance No. 250, on the 20th day of November, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, after the budget was adopted, certain amendments to City operations were identified which would better accommodate the needs of the City, for which it would appropriate to vary the budgetary allocations contemplated in the original adopted budget; and,

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish such changes, it is appropriate that the 2001 budget be amended to provide such change in budgetary allocation.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. 2001 BUDGET AMENDED.

The 2001 budget for the City of Lakewood, covering the period from January 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001, as adopted by Ordinance No. 250, be, and the same hereby is amended to reflect the Funds, Revenues, Sources and Balances, with amended 2001 Budget totals, of \$69,428,750 each for Revenues and for Expenditures, as shown on the summaries attached hereto, marked respectively as Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B," both of which are incorporated herein by this reference.

#### Section 2. COPIES OF BUDGET TO BE FILED.

A complete copy of the final budget as adopted herein shall be transmitted to the Division of Municipal Corporations in the Office of the State Auditor, and to the Municipal Research and Services Center of Washington. Three complete copies of the final budget as adopted herein shall be filed with the City Clerk and shall be available for use by the public.

Section 3. SALARY RANGES FOR NEW/CHANGED EMPLOYEE POSITIONS.

The list of Employee Position Titles, Salaries and Salary Ranges, and the amounts of employee salaries and costs in the 2001 budget, shall be amended to reflect the following changes and modifications, with all other unchanged salaried and positions

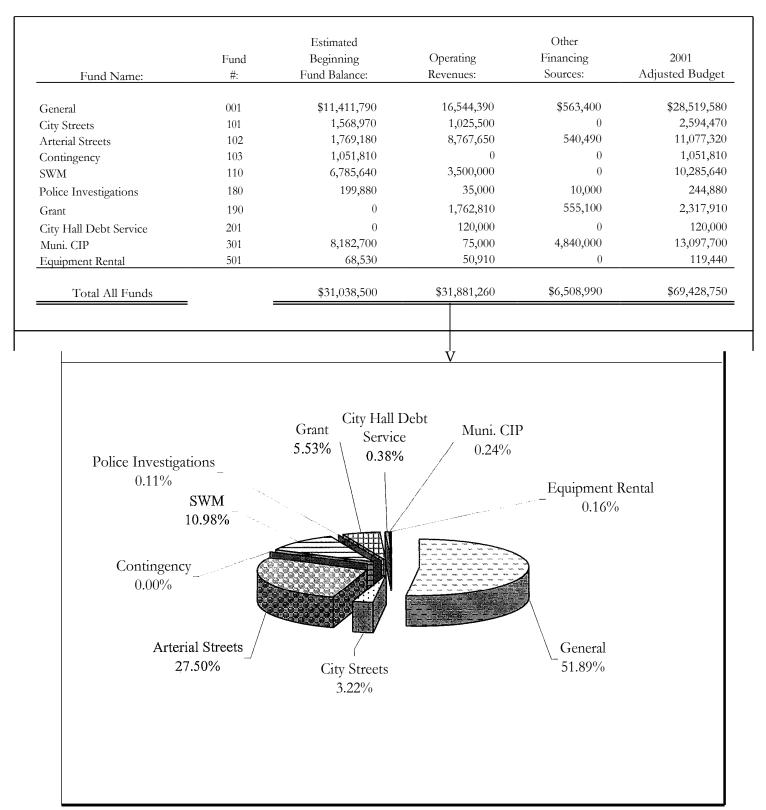

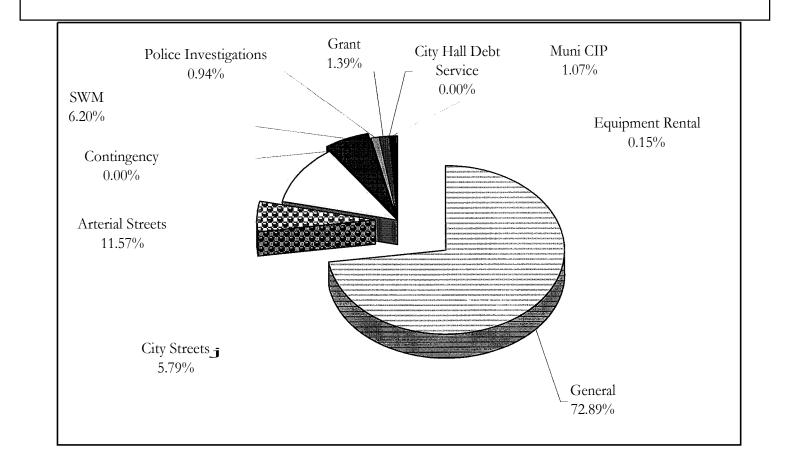
## City of Lakewood 2001 1st Adjusted Budget - Revenues - All Funds
