RESOLUTION NO. 1997-24

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, adopting an Interim Non-Motorized Transportation Plan

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35.77.015 of the Revised Code of Washington, cities are to consider, where ever practical and reasonable, provisions for bicycle routes in connection with their six-year comprehensive street programs; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing on the 16th day of June, 1997, pursuant to state law, to hear and receive public comment on the City's proposed Interim Non-Motorized Transportation Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that non-motorized plans are essential parts of its transportation plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as Follows:

Section 1. That the Interim Non-Motorized Transportation Plan for the City of Lakewood, a copy of which is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit 'A", and incorporated by this reference, be and the same is adopted.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
