WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood, Washington, has determined through an evaluation of its needs for streets and right-of-ways in the vicinity of vacation of a portion of the Douglas Street W. right-of-way that said stretch of City right-of-way is no longer needed to meet the needs of the City and that a public hearing should be set to determine if said right-of-way should be vacated; and,
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35.79.010 of the Revised Code of Washington, a hearing on such vacation shall be set by Resolution, with the date of such hearing being not more than sixty (60) days nor less than twenty (20) days after the date of passage of such Resolution.
NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:
1. That a hearing on the vacation of a portion of the Douglas Street W. right-of-way, located within the City of Lakewood, Washington, described as follows:
"That portion of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 20 North, Range 2 East, W.M., City of Lakewood, Pierce County, Washington, more fully described as follows: The Douglas Street W. right-of-way consisting of a strip of land 60 feet wide beginning 40 feet south of the right-of-way centerline of 75th Street W. and ending at the Northerly margin line of 76th Street W. Containing 17460 Square Feet or 0.401 Acres more or less."
be, and the same hereby is set for 7:00p.m. on the 6th day of July, 1999, at the City Council Chambers at 10510 Gravelly Lake Drive S.W., Lakewood, Washington.
2. That this Resolution shall be in full force in effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
