## RESOLUTION NO. 1999-25

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, adopting a Six-Year comprehensive Transportation Program for 2000 through 2005

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35.77.010 of the Revised Code of Washington, cities are required to adopt a six-year comprehensive transportation program, in July of each year with that program including a six-year program for arterial street construction; and,

WHEREAS, the growth management act, Chapter 17, first extraordinary session, laws of 1990, at Section 59 similarly requires adoption by the City of a comprehensive transportation program, to include a section listing planned arterial street construction; and,

WHEREAS, the City council conducted a public hearing on the 19th day of July, 1999; pursuant to state law, to hear and receive public comment on the City's Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Program for the years 2000 through 2005; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that prioritized road and street capital improvement projects are essential to proper planning and the improvement of transportation within the City, as well as being prerequisites for certain grant funding programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as Follows:

Section 1. The Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for the years 2000 through 2005, a copy of which is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A", and incorporated by this reference is adopted.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to use the Comprehensive Transportation Program in applications for grant funding for transportation related projects, and further authorizes the City Manager or designee to apply for such grants based thereon.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
