RESOLUTION NO. 2001-03

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, authorizing an Interlocal Agreement for STOP Grant administration

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW), the Interlocal Cooperation Act, allows local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate and enter into agreements with each other to accomplish mutually beneficial public purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the Cities of Lakewood, Puyallup and Fife have applied and received funding for STOP Grant funds through the Office of Crime Victims Advocacy, and,

WHEREAS, in connection therewith, there are certain administrative functions that must be addressed; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it desirable and in the City's best interest to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the Cities of Fife and Puyallup for administration of STOP Grant funds.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:

1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Lakewood an Interlocal Agreement in substantial conformity with the agreement a copy of which is set attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
