RESOLUTION NO. 2002-28

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, providing for amendment to the City of Lakewood Fee Schedule, to provide for business license fees therein, and updating the schedule of fees adopted through prior Ordinances and Resolutions accordingly.

WHEREAS, in connection with the municipal functions and operations of the City of Lakewood, the City provides various public services, a number of which entail fees; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council provided for adoption of fee schedules in the adoption of Ordinance No. 18, and Resolution Numbers 1996-4, 1996-5, 1996-14, 1996-32, 1997-7; 1997-14, 1997-18, 1997-31, 1997-32, 1998-10, 1998-14, 1998-16, 1999-17, 2000-18, 2001-08, 2001-11, 2001-24, 2001-30 and 2002-11; and,

WHEREAS, in keeping with the philosophy of setting City fees in amounts reflective of actual costs, it is also appropriate at this time to increase Animal Control Licensing fees to compensate the City for costs associated with these services provided by the City; and,

WHEREAS, the convenience of consolidating City fees in the fee schedule, so that they are all consistently accessible, prompts the inclusion of business license fees in the City's fee schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as follows:

Section 1. That the Fee Schedule of the City of Lakewood is amended to include fees for business licenses detailed in Title 5 of the Lakewood Municipal Code, and the Fee Schedule is accordingly updated with the inclusion of the fees as set forth on the document attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

I. ANIMAL CONTROL LICENSING FEES

The annual license fees for the ownership, keeping, or having control of dogs and/or cats in the City shall be as follows:

A. Adult Dogs: altered -- -- \$ 10.00

unaltered -- -- \$50.00

B. Juvenile Dogs: -- -- \$ 4.00

C. Adult Cats: altered -- -- \$ 10.00

unaltered -- -- \$50.00

D. Juvenile Cats: -- -- \$ 4.00

E. Reduced rates for senior citizens, sixty-five years of age or older:

1. Dogs: altered -- -- \$ 5.00

unaltered -- -- \$30.00

2. Cats: altered -- -- \$ 4.00

unaltered -- -- \$30.00

It is provided, however, that animal control license fees for renewal of 2001 licenses shall be prorated in the year 2002 to reflect the proportionate share of the year 2002 remaining had the 2001 license continued to be in effect for a full twelve month term from the date of its issuance. (This provision shall automatically sunset after the year 2002.)

In order to receive the fee advantage for altered dogs and cats, an individual must provide either proof of alteration from a licensed veterinarian or a written statement from a licensed veterinarian that the spay/neuter procedure would be harmful to the animal.
