RESOLUTION NO. 2004-05

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, acknowledging community partnership councils for fiscal year 2004.

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood believes in the importance of community involvement in its public service delivery system, including public safety; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood has established many community based policing programs; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood has established partnerships with community councils in five of its six police districts over the past several years; and,

WHEREAS, these partnerships include working together to reduce crime and enhance the livability in those areas through community involvement in policing programs, improving opportunities for youth, neighborhood improvement projects and community outreach and mobilization; and,

WHEREAS, it is important to formally acknowledge these partnerships so that they can provide the greatest benefit to the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as Follows:

Section 1. That the City of Lakewood does hereby acknowledge Lakeview Neighborhood Association, Lake City Neighborhood Association, Northeast Neighborhood Association, Pacific Neighborhood Association and the Tillicum Woodbrook Neighborhood Association with copies of their bylaws and a list of current board members on record with the City as Community Partnership Councils for fiscal year 2004.

Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, or its application held inapplicable to any person, property or circumstance, such invalidity or unconstitutionality or inapplicability shall not effect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution or its application to any other person, property or circumstance.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
