## RESOLUTION NO. 2015-35

A RESOLUTION of the City of Lakewood City Council, setting a public hearing on January 4, 2016 for consideration on Amendment 1 of the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program (2016 through 2021).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35.77.010 of the Revised Code of Washington, cities are required to adopt a six-year comprehensive transportation improvement program and to review that program annually; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of annual review is to assure consistency with comprehensive planning, to review the work accomplished under the plan, and to determine current transportation needs, including a six-year program for arterial street construction and any new or enhanced bicycle or pedestrian facilities as needed to promote non-motorized transit; and,

WHEREAS, the current Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program (2016-2021) was adopted on July 20, 2015 and may be amended following a public hearing and receive public comments on any amendments prior to adoption of said program.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as follows:

Section 1. That a public hearing is hereby set for the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016, for the City Council to hear and receive comment on Amendment 1 of the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program for the years 2016 through 2021. This public hearing will be held at 7:00 p.m. at the City of Lakewood Council Chambers, 6000 Main Street S.W., Lakewood, Washington 98499. The City Clerk is authorized to provide notice of this public hearing as required by law.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
