RESOLUTION NO. 1996-06

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, authorizing and approving the interlocal agreement between Pierce County Fire Protection District #2 and the City relating to Fire Code Services.

WHEREAS, as of February 28, 1996, the incorporation date of the City of Lakewood, the City will be the responsible jurisdiction for enforcement of provisions within its City Code, including the Uniform Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, because the Uniform Fire Code (adopted by reference as a part of the City Code) provides for certain duties and responsibilities and provides for authorities with respect to Code enforcement, it would be advantageous for the City to make arrangements for providing those services; and

WHEREAS, because State law allows the fire district operating within a newly incorporated City to continue providing those services, it would be advantageous for the City to allow services consistent with the Fire Protection District activities to be done on behalf of the City and to handle those responsibilities that fall on the newly incorporated City; and

WHEREAS, the City and Fire Protection District #2 of Pierce County have negotiated an agreement beneficial and agreeable to both which provides for enforcement of the Uniform Fire Code and enforcement of other responsibilities falling on the City in connection with fire related activities, including identification of the Fire Marshal for the City, a position having specific statutory duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, it would be advantageous for the City to enter into the agreement with the fire district for the Fire Code and related services.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as Follows:

Section 1. That the interlocal agreement between the City and Pierce County Fire Protection District #2 relating to enforcement of the Uniform Fire Code and Fire Code duties, a copy of which is attached hereto marked as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, be, and the same hereby is approved, and that the City Manager is authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
