RESOLUTION NO. 1996-11

A RESOLUTION of the City of Lakewood, Washington, ratifying actions of the City Council during the interim period prior to the City's official incorporation date

WHEREAS, voters of Lakewood voted to incorporate the new City of Lakewood at an election held on March 14, 1995, and the City Council was duly elected on September 19, 1995, and sworn in on October 11, 1995; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council established its official date of incorporation as February 28, 1996; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 35.02 of the Revised Code of Washington, during the interim period prior to the official date of incorporation, the City Council established laws and administrative regulations and procedures, to become effective on the official date of incorporation.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as follows:

Section 1. Ratification. The City Council hereby ratifies and confirms all acts of the City Council of the City of Lakewood during the interim period prior to the City's official date of incorporation, including but not limited to the passage of resolutions, adoption of Ordinances and the execution of contracts.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effectively immediately upon signing.
