RESOLUTION NO. 1996-14

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, providing for amendment to the City of Lakewood Public Works Fees, adding right-of-way permit fees and Miscellaneous Business License fees

WHEREAS, in connection with the municipal functions and operations of the City of Lakewood, the City will be handling various public works issues, a number of which entail fees; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council provided for adoption of certain public works fees in the adoption of its Resolution No. 1996-5, passed on February 12, 1996; and,

WHEREAS, in order for the City to fully address the public works permit needs, and to provide for reasonable fees to recover the costs to the City when private businesses or individuals engage in work in public right-of-ways, particularly where such work may impact and/or restrict pedestrian and vehicular use of the public right-of-ways, the public works fees schedule should be amended to reflect appropriate fees; and,

WHEREAS, in addition to the Public Works fees to be charged, there is a need to amend the Miscellaneous Business License fees to increase the Finger Printing fee to conform to the Pierce County Sheriff's program costs; and,

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the City Council to amend the fee schedule adopted in Resolution No. 1996-5 to address the Public Works Fees for work in public right-of-ways and Miscellaneous Business License fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as Follows:

Section 1. That the Public Works Fees as set forth on the document attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, are amended and adopted as the Public Works Fees for the City.

Section 2. That the Miscellaneous Business License fees as set forth on the document attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by this reference, are amended and adopted as the Miscellaneous Business License fees for the City.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
