## RESOLUTION NO. 1996-17

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, authorizing execution of an agreement with Pierce County for maintenance of streets, signs, signals, sidewalks and drainage systems

WHEREAS, following the incorporation of the City of Lakewood, the City will be responsible for various municipal functions and operations, including, ultimately, maintenance of streets, right-of-way appurtenances and drainage systems; and,

WHEREAS, even though RCW 35.02.220 provides that the County would have a continuing responsibility for maintenance of city roads for a period of up to sixty (60) days following the official date of incorporation, after that period, it would be advantageous for the City to take advantage of the available maintenance resources in existence by the County, at least until such time as the City is able to provide for maintenance services on its own; and,

WHEREAS, in connection with the City's need for road maintenance services, a Contract has been negotiated between the City and the County for County services to maintain City streets, signs, signals, sidewalks and drainage systems with terms acceptable and beneficial to both parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as Follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Lakewood, a Contract with Pierce County for maintenance of City streets, signs, signals, sidewalks and drainage systems, in general conformity with the Draft copy of such a Contract which is attached hereto marked as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. That the authority provided by this Resolution to execute such a Contract on behalf of the City shall include parameters in price not to exceed ten percent (10%) above the estimated cost of the Contract, to wit: One Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,900,000) for the period of the remainder of term of the Contract, provided that if the amount of the Contract exceeds by more than five percent (5%) the above figure, the matter should be returned to the City Council for consideration of such further amount(s).

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
