Section 1. <u>Transit Board Bylaw Amendment</u> . The Lakewood City Council requests that the Pierce Transit Board hold a special meeting to consider amendment of its bylaws to create two additional board seats. One seat would be for a member selected by the Lakewood City Council. The other seat would be for a member selected by the University Place City Council.
NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as Follows:
WHEREAS, Lakewood and University Place represent major urban centers in Pierce County and consultation with the two cities is essential to sound regional transportation planning.
WHEREAS, the Cities of Lakewood and University Place are the second and third largest cities in Pierce County and are concerned about the mobility of their citizens, but are not represented on the Pierce Transit Board; and,
WHEREAS, public transportation plays an important role in making jobs, shopping, medical care and other services more accessible to all citizens;
A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, requesting the Pierce County Transit Board amend its bylaws to create two new board seats for members from the Cities of Lakewood and University Place
