RESOLUTION NO. 1996-44

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, expressing its position with respect to the final E.I.S. for the Northwest Landing Off-Site Waste Water Facilities

WHEREAS, in connection with the proposed project by Pierce County for the Northwest Landing Off-Site Waste Water Facilities, Pierce County has engaged in an environmental review which resulted in the preparation of a final E.I.S. for the project; and,

WHEREAS, that final E.I.S., in general, appears to adequately address comments submitted by various agencies and individuals who commented on the draft E.I.S.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES, as Follows:

Section 1. A. That the position of the Lakewood City Council is to support the Tatsolo Point alternative as the preferred and the least environmentally impactful and most economical alternative, with the understanding that all National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit requirements shall be complied with.

B. That the City Council is emphatically opposed to the Farwest Drive - Oakbrook alternative and the Farwest Drive - Western State Hospital alternative, due to their considerably greater environmental impacts on both the natural and built environment, and further due to the greatly increased impacts these alternatives would have on the citizens of Lakewood and Pierce County.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and signatures hereon.
